




Bless the Lord, O my soul; Bless-ed art Thou, O Lord.




Bless the Lord, O my soul,

And his right - eous - ness is up - on sons of sons,


up - on them that keep his tes - ta - ment

and re - mem - ber his com - mand - ments to do them.


The Lord in heav - en hath pre - pared his throne,

and his king - dom rul - eth ov - er all.


Bless the Lord, all you his an - gels,



mighty in strength, that per-form his word, to hear the voice of his words.




Bless the Lord, all you his hosts, his mi-nis-ters that do his will.
